- Some women displayed great interest in the training, and were keen on learning how to keep their community safe in times of disaster.
- Most of the women in the village if not all were illiterate, belonging to agri-based households, however, showed great interest when asked if they'd like to learn to read and write or other skills.
- Sweet meats and juices were distributed amongst the participants at the end of the assembly.
