MOBILE BAREFOOT KARAVAN TEAMS

During the month of April, Heritage Foundation's Mobile Barefoot Karavan Team continues its relentless efforts to Build Back Safer with Vernacular Methodologies, with DRR Compliant Sustainable Construction for the community in Village Obayo Mir, District Tando Allayar. Housing units were retrofitted with Karavan Roofs while damages to walls were rectified using bamboo infill and mud brick. Awareness Campaigns were held for the community to explain the importance of disaster resilient measures, such as the construction of a toe at the base of walls, the use of lime in mortars and plasters and strong resilient roofs. With the completion of the units in the village, community members have learnt methods of Disaster Risk Reduction gaining experience that will create resilient communities.

The community attended a training workshop at the beginning of the programme to understand the correct method of tying the Karavan 6-bamboo joists to the ring beam, anchoring of walls to both base and roof. Once bases were strengthened with toes and platforms, walls repaired with infill, and KararvanRoofs secured, community members were urged to test their new and improved housing unit, by collecting 15 people of the community on the roof. Communal buildings are now required to ensure that people have additional space for safety during times of the monsoon. We are now looking for support for the construction of a small dispensary and a women's centre which would be completed at a cost of Rs. 150,000.
