

HF-ILO GREEN SKILLS CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTION CEREMONY

A certificate distribution ceremony was held at Sanjar Khaskheli, Mirpur Khas on the 9th of September, 2014. Over 300 women and men from villages Dewan Goth and Dayo Patel, alongside Sanjar Khaskheli attended in a colourful manner.

The certificates were distributed by Ms. Shama Maqbool, National Project Coordinator ILO and Ar. Yasmeen Lari, CEO Heritage Foundation of Pakistan. The ceremony was arranged by HF's field teams headed by Mr. Naheem Shah and assisted by Ms. Sumaira Batool.

On the occasion, addresses were made by Ar. Yasmeen Lari, Ms. Shama Maqbool, Mr. Naheem Shah and several successful Barefoot Village Entrepreneurs related to their success stories. The work on Karavan Latrines and Karavan Pakoswiss Chulahs has proceeded extremely well in all 3 villages that have been declared HF's Core Villages. In addition village of Sanjar Khaskheli has shown great initiative in promoting the skills in neighbouring satellite village of Dault Laghari. In the process Sanjar Khaskheli's Barefoot Village Entrepreneurs have been able to generate considerable income through the use of green skills that they have learnt from HF Trainers.

In addition, to proceed forward with Parho Pakistan School initiative in Sanjar Khaskheli, Ar. Yasmeen Lari presented the school a laptop gifted by Mr. Babar Khan. The village has appointed a local teacher who received training by Moak Sharif's Parho Pakistan teacher, Ms. Heer, who shall now begin the classes with IAM Momal (HF's Parho Pakistan initiative) books.
